1. Apologies given from members unable to attend
2. Minutes from previous meeting confirmed
3. West Coast jersey
  - About \$300 to frame
  - Decided not to frame it, sell it for a profit – paid \$65 for it
  - Start by auctioning it, starting at \$65
4. Office Bearers
  - Treasurer will keep a list of financial members, roles and responsibilities on website
5. Outside office board on the way

7. Treasurer's Report
  - About \$13, 633 in bank
  - Since beginning of year until now roughly \$4000 from fundraising
8. Treasurer moved to buy items

  - Principal wants electronic board for kindy, data projector in the undercover area
  - Principal suggests that the e-board for kindy purchased now
  - Committee moved and seconded that the P&C will get the e-board now and fundraise for the data projector in the future
9. Principal's Report
  - 1 new student, we have lost 2 students due to movement
  - 4 interschool sports events, carnival
  - Book fair coming up
  - 3 assemblies coming up
  - Wellness Day, get to know you speed dating, etc coming up
  - Sporting Schools Funding – surfing lessons, also years 3 and 4 will be doing cycling, years 1 and 2 are doing little athletics
  - Highlights – surf gala day, Anzac Day service, Mother's Day afternoon, Naplan Week
  - Updates – kindy enrolments open until end of July 2016
  - State government giving opportunity to school to apply for a \$20,000 grant to refurbish existing equipment
  - State Government gave a dollar for dollar grant for ICT – school purchased 2 lots of IPADS – each class now has a set of IPADS
  - Anita Coddling has been doing a series of PD programs about using IPADS –part of new curriculum called digital technologies
  - Met with Will West, manager for fathering project, plan is to target a group of 6 to 8 fathers to meet with Will to develop fatherhood training
10. Canteen
  - Bruce unsure if he can be manager of the canteen continuing on
  - P&C will need a manager who is a P&C member
  - Canteen will soon be supplying sushi
