School Banking is every Tuesday, in the corridor outside Room 2.

Students need to have a Commonwealth account, then simply bring in their deposit book and we can assign them a student number. For each deposit a student makes they receive a silver token 10 Silver tokens = 1 Gold token.

Each term there are different rewards the students can exchange their Gold token for, ranging from Markers, Pencil Cases, Headphone, Handballs to name a few.

Our menu is compliant with the Department of Education & Scarborough Primary School's Healthy Food and Drink Policies, and we are also working towards becoming accredited as a StarCap 2 Canteen. Our menu has been rated by the WA Canteen Association as 85% green, well above the minimum requirement of 60%. All Items on our menu are coded either GREEN or AMBER to help you when ordering.

UNIFORM SHOP

Our Uniform Shop is now located in the Library (complete with a changing area) and Trish Springer will be there on Wednesday mornings between 8:35-9:00AM. You can also contact Trish to arrange an appointment at a mutually convenient time around school hours to get your uniforms.

Orders can also be placed by texting Trish, leaving money in the Uniform Shop box at school reception, or paying direct deposit to the Uniform Shop Account (on the green order form available at school reception). If you place an order in the box please advise Trish by text.

The uniform shop is quite low on second hand uniform stock at the moment, so please take a look at what you have at home and if you have any uniforms which are no longer needed, we will gladly accept them.

In compliance with West Australian Department of Education Healthy Food and Drink (HDF) policy the Canteen will use wholemeal bread and wraps as well as reduced fat dairy products.

- Green foods and drinks are the healthiest choices. They are excellent sources of important nutrients needed for health and wellbeing; low in saturated fat, added sugar and salt; and are lower in energy density.
- Amber foods have some nutritional value; contain moderate levels of saturated fat, added sugar and/or salt; in large serve sizes contribute to excess energy intake.

P&C ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

PURPOSE OF THE P&C

To work together as parents and community members for the benefit of the students at our school. This doesn't just mean fundraising for additional resources and amenities for the benefit of our students, although that's a large part. We are also providing opportunities for parents to learn about our school's policies and programs; assisting our school to build positive attitudes to students and their families; stimulating interest and participation in education; bringing parents together to share information and views; facilitating the development of our whole school community – teachers, students and families.



There are six elected roles, however anyone over the age of 18 can join our P&C as a General Member, which entitles them to contribute, participate and vote on all P&C matters. We generally have two meetings per term, so come along and see what it's all about!

PRESIDENT

- Elected spokesperson of our P&C, our public representative
- Chairperson of meetings
- General supervisor of the functions of the other Office Bearers
- Ensures adequate and efficient communication between members and between the P&C and the School
- Encourages other to participate in the activities and objectives of the P&C

TREASURER

- Responsible for all monies received and expended on behalf of the P&C
- Clerical work – writing cheques, arranging EFT payments, banking money
- Financial management – assisting the P&C on budgets, monitoring accounts
- Accounting – producing financial reports for yearly audit

SECRETARY

- Collection of mail from the Front Office and conducting the P&C correspondence
- Maintaining the registers of Members
- Custody of all P&C documents (excluding financial records) – such as Constitution; Certificate of Incorporation; Minutes
- Preparing minutes and agendas for each meeting

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBERS

- To ensure all P&C decisions made are to the benefit of the school, the students, the families
- Assist on Sub-Committee(s), such as Canteen, Uniform, Fundraising
