I sent a letter to all families yesterday regarding children on school grounds at the end of the school day. In recent years we have allowed children to play after school on the oval and playground equipment when they are supervised by an adult. In the last few weeks I have received reports of children staying after school who are unsupervised. This has led to a number of issues including damage to school property, injuries, inappropriate language and poor behaviour choices. Students who do not have an adult supervising them need to vacate the school at the end of the school day or go to the school office for collection. All students were reminded at the assembly that if they cannot find their parent or they are unsure what to do after school they should come to the front office and one of the staff can contact a parent by phone. The school has an onsite after school care provider, Mulberry Tree, and a number of students also attend Brighton Kids after school care. Details of these services can be found in this newsletter. If you are running a few minutes late please contact the front office and a message can be passed on to your child; they are always welcome to wait in the front office until you arrive.

Lost Property continues to build up in the undercover area. All items with names were returned by the Wellbeing Council during the week. Please label all items coming to school in an obvious place so they can be returned.

Our new house point cards have arrived. Thanks to Mrs Smith for organising this great addition to our positive values program. When a student receives a house point card they need to put it into the house box located near Room 2. At each assembly some lucky students will be drawn out for prizes. All the cards will be returned to students to take home and show their family. Our next house activity afternoon will be occurring on Friday 8 June after lunch. Thank you to Mrs Salt and the House Captains for organising the afternoon.

The crosswalk on Scarborough Beach Road is going to be audited in the coming weeks. To keep our crosswalk I encourage families to use it if they live on the northern side of Scarborough Beach Road.






