#### 3.2 Dads Race -

Sports Day is rescheduled to 15<sup>th</sup> Sep however currently the weather's looking bad again so the sports carnival activities may involve students being in and out around the weather. SQ advised we should know by 10/9 or 11/9 how it will look but we may need to completely cancel the Dads race.

#### 3.3 Feedback Survey Results -

79 responses.

#of events – generally about right

Fundraising events – Top = Playground & Resilience Program
Other suggestions about community family events, community garden,
digital skills, onsite sports & music programs, Brighton Rd calming
works, permanent sports goals.

Current oval playground was approx \$40k. Kindy playground was \$80k.

Two programs are to run through school chaplain. SPS develops our program through the 'Be You' umbrella. Nikki is currently training the teachers and it will be up and running to implement fully for 2026 school year.

We get federal funding for the chaplain. Hard to advise parents exactly what is being taught in class but the fortnightly values are followed – e.g. currently it is sportsmanship.

Chess Club – Most popular days were Tues or Weds after school. Other OSH suggestions – Top = Science, Drama, Art, Music/Dance, incursions

Space – Library and Art room part of Camp Aus lease. Upstairs space is limited due to teachers needing it after school. Possibly music room but day dependant. Meeting room could currently be best option?

Science – Stargazing option? UWA and few companies offer the services. They bring all the equipment. Great option for a free event.

#### Current canteen day -

Even split between current day & Friday so will leave as is. JK suggested using canteen again & employing someone but MF looked into previous profit and it wasn't much, with a lot of extra responsibility – super, legislations. No for now.

#### Brighton Rd -

High answer that it's unsafe currently & many said they would use a crossing if there was one. Volunteers for crossing person – 10 people. Benefits of having a crossing is it changes the road to a 'school zone' area.

# 3.4 WACSSO Conference -

TS attended only. WACSSO provide resources training and advocacy for P&C – federal voice in govt for us.

Grant writing workshop was interesting and could assist when doing Brighton Rd application.

EF now in a group with Presidents of other P&Cs – will keep us updated with anything of interest.

#### 3.5 Colour Run -

12<sup>th</sup> Dec. TS spoke with company today. Need to confirm numbers – approx 280.

Prizes – dependant on amount students raise. Can select prizes on profile or if wish to donate to a charity.

More students fundraise, the more comes back into P&C.

Last year only 97 profiles were made but P&C made \$7k. We get 60% of the funds raised.

Fundraising will open 15<sup>th</sup> Oct. Close 20<sup>th</sup> Nov. Want to push people to create profile and start fundraising.

Not compulsory to raise funds/create a profile, all kids will take part regardless.

3.5 TS to confirm numbers.

EF to look into MSC last year – did we get people to get \$0 tickets or was it for volunteers? Year group chats for volunteers this year.

When putting out info we need to be very clear on how it works & where the money will go.

Look into where taps are and see if can attach hoses to feed water arches.

#### 3.6 Christmas Tea Towels -

Artwork went out. All in class so most have completed already. Teachers give back to office. End of term EF and TS collect all, put together to company and they issue a proof to us.

Price per tea towel – agreed on \$17. Fairly small profit.
